# **Innovations Made**

- <u>New structure</u>: developing materials, conducting simex, debriefing
- More hands-on tasks: brief RC, draft injects, present to HCT, debriefing
- <u>Observed real simulation</u>: fire-fighter training drill

## **General Observations**

- 1. MSB pulled out all stops, again.
- 2. Simulation gaining ground as a preparedness tool.
- 3. Greater experience among trainees (e.g., ECB, IFRC, NEMO)
- 4. Same training team, better results.

# **Participant Evaluations**

- 1. Nine out of 13 sessions ranked 4+ on 5-point Leikert scale.
- 2. Twelve of 13 sessions ranked 3.5+
- 3. Comments: "engaging; relevant; appropriate; fun; useful; practical."
- 4. Key suggestion: run a real simex.
