- Additional 1.5 million people need shelter

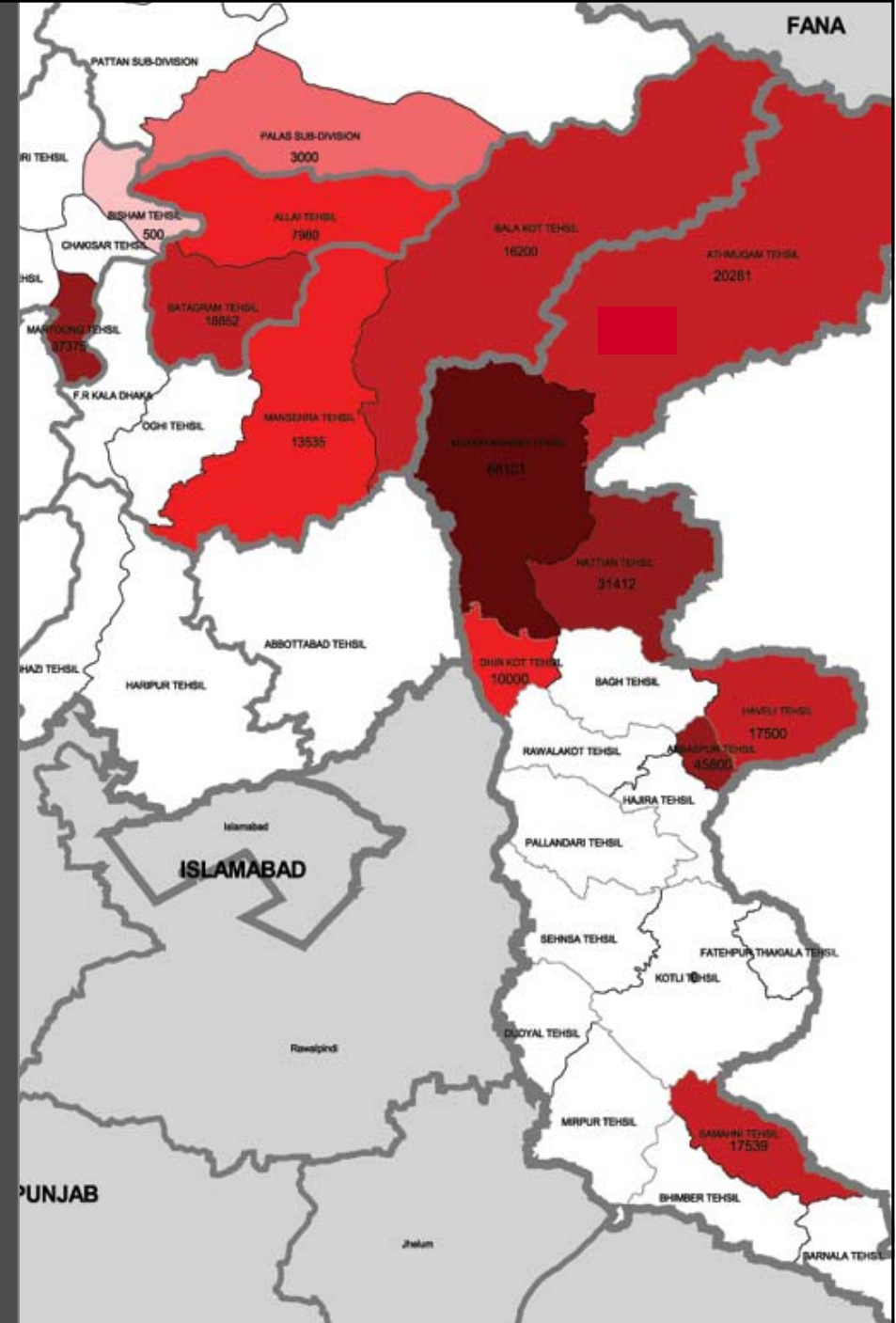
» Blankets

- 22 Therapeutic feeding centres

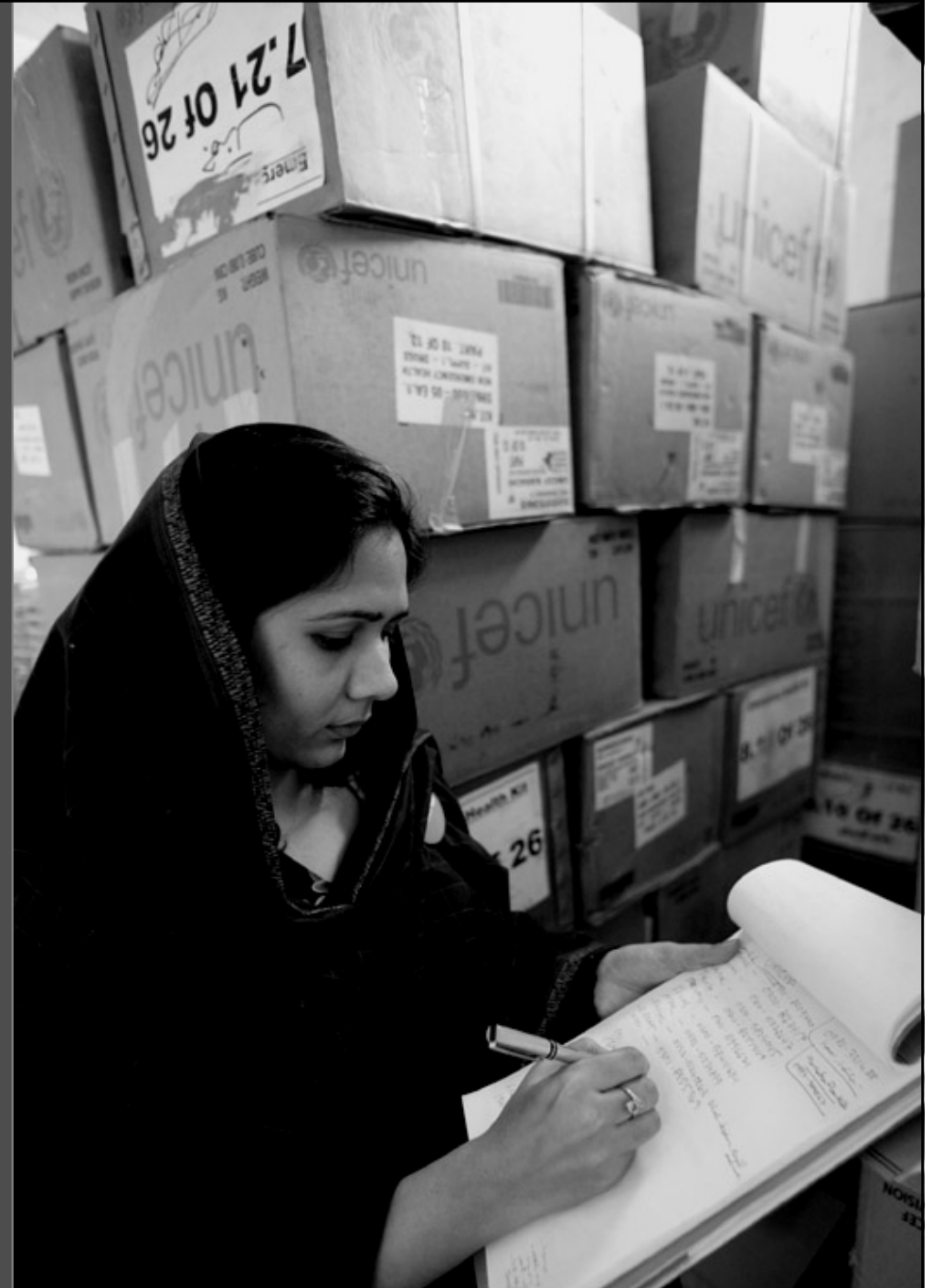

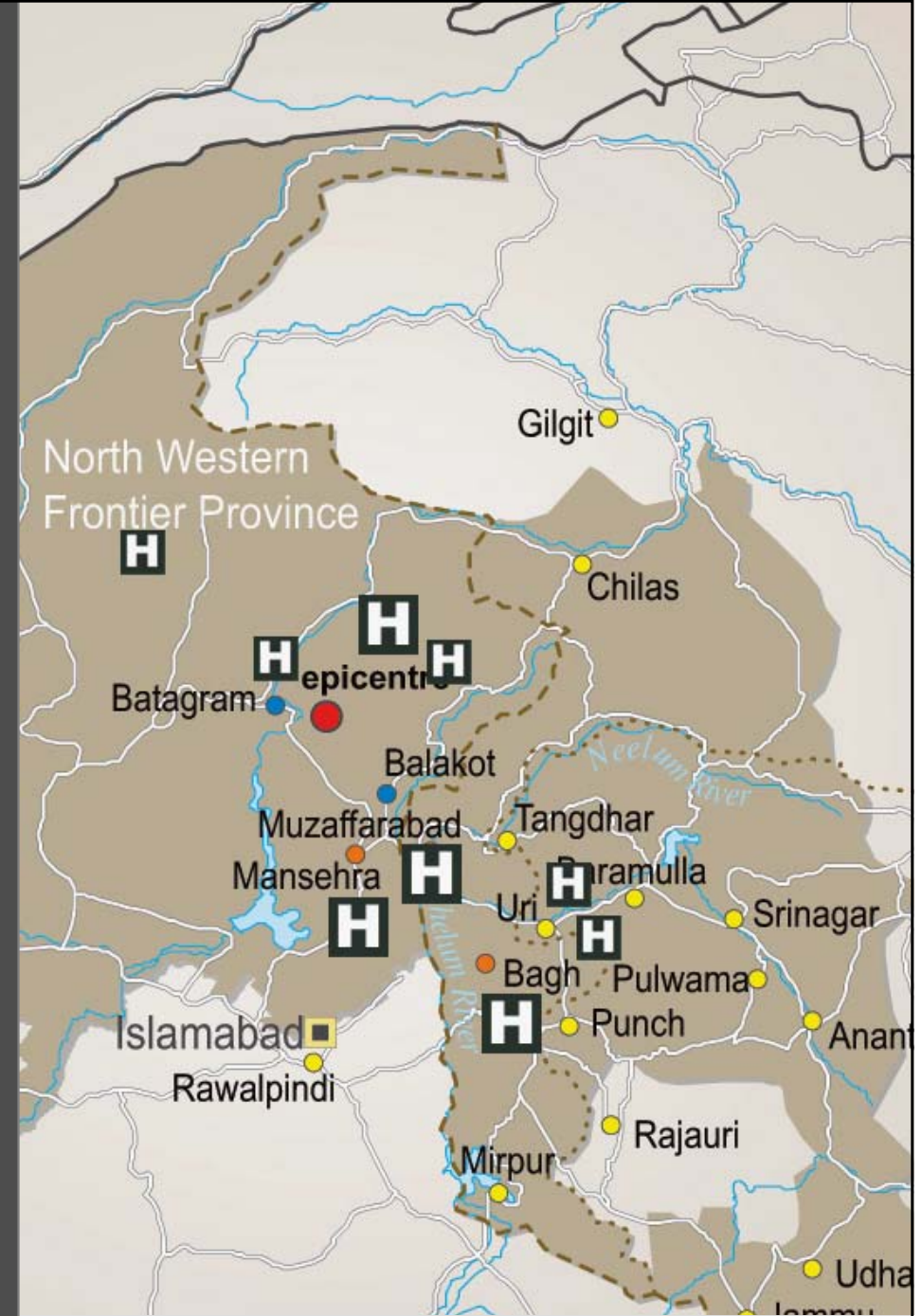
