**Consolidated Appeals Process (CAP):**  
*Countries or Regions for a CAP in 2006 (revised)*

**Circulated: 20 June 2005**

The first fourteen countries and regions in the list are based on various criteria, such as views expressed in the field by members of Country Teams, OCHA Office, Humanitarian Coordinators; the 2005 Mid-Year Reviews; whether or not an HC or CT has requested a CAP workshop to plan for 2006; whether or not there is currently a CAP; and on views expressed by agency HQs and in the IASC SWG on the CAP.

The countries listed in items 15-21 are places where: acute humanitarian need exists; no one entity or organisation is able to address all needs; and where agencies or OCHA (field or HQs) have suggested the need for a strategic planning, advocacy, and/or coordinated fundraising tool.
