IASC COUNTRY-LEVEL IMPLEMENTATION OF PSEA: 3 PRIORITY OUTCOMES

REPORTING



In all humanitarian situations:

Outcome 1. Safe and accessible reporting for every affected child and adult in humanitarian contexts.

SURVIVOR SUPPORT



Outcome 2. Quality and accessible SEA survivor assistance.

Outcome 3. Every child survivor of SEA has their case investigated in a prompt, safe and respectful way.

ACCOUNTABILITY



IASC: Framework for IASC Accelerating PSEA in Humanitarian Responses, with 3 priority outcomes, endorsed December 2018 by IASC Principals

EXAMPLES OF WHAT SUCCESS WOULD LOOK LIKE AT COUNTRY LEVEL



Outcomes

Outcome 1: Every child and adult has access to safe and child sensitive SEA reporting mechanism.



- One harmonized reporting system on PSEA at country level
- Functional Community Based Complaint Mechanisms in most at risk locations



Outcome 2: Every child and adult who reports SEA accesses immediate, quality SEA assistance in line with a survivor centered approach.

- SEA survivor assistance provided by CP and GBV actors on the basis of shared responsibilities among IASC members
- PSEA Network SOPs aligned to IASC standards on SEA survivor assistance
- Capacity building plan in place for CP and GBV partners on SEA survivor assistance, principles and protocols, with linkages to PSEA Network referral and reporting procedures



Outcome 3: Every child and adult survivor of SEA will have their case investigated in a prompt, safe, respectful way.

- Support provided to the HCT/UNCT to develop a PSEA Action Plan, including costing and timeframes/benchmarks
- Capacity building plan in place on child-sensitive, survivorcentered principles and standards for SEA investigations

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To support **IASC system-wide changes**, ED Fore has asked members of the IASC to contribute dedicated resources on PSEA, for countries with humanitarian or refugee response to put in place the necessary reporting and response systems.

Leading by Example

ED Fore has allocated **\$11 million of internal resources** to the PSEA, as part of an organization commitment and to deliver on her leadership agenda. Funds are allocated to 16 Country Offices and 3 Regional Offices strengthen critical elements of PSEA.

ERC Mark Lowcock has mobilized **\$1 million fund for investigations**, as part of the IASC's commitment to strengthen PSEA and commitment to integrate PSEA into **humanitarian pooled funds**.








Purpose:




- To strengthen coherence of IASC efforts on PSEA at the country level while enabling effective monitoring of progress and reporting of aggregated results at the global level.
