## **WHEN**

The Inter-Agency Standing Committee (IASC) Operational Policy and Advocacy Group (OPAG) will meet on 7-8 November 2019 from 9.00 am to 5.00 pm (coffee will be served from 8.30 a.m. for both days).

## **WHERE**

The meeting will take place at the **Starling Hotel**, located at 34, route François-Peyrot, 1218 Le Grand-Saconnex in Geneva, Switzerland.

#### **SECURITY**

Please ensure that you bring an official ID with you for meeting registration purposes.

## FREE SHUTTLE BUS TO/FROM THE AIRPORT

Free shuttle bus from the Geneva International Airport to Starling Hotel will be provided at the arrival level, gate 3, departing every 15 minutes from 5.10 am to 11.45 pm.

#### **TAXI**

Participants should make a reservation at least 30 minutes in advance with Taxiphone Genève at +41 22 33 141 33. Uber is also operational in Geneva.

#### **BUS**

"Gd Saconnex place" stop is the closest to the hotel. Bus no.5 (direction "Aeroport") runs from Geneva's railway station (Cornavin) to "Gd Saconnex place". Bus no.5 (direction "Thonex-Vallard") also runs from Geneva Airport to "Gd Saconnex place". In addition to bus no. 5, buses 5+, 53 and F stop at the "Gd Saconnex place".
